

# THE WORLD EQUESTRIAN GAMES RETURN TO EUROPE

For the World Equestrian Games' return to Europe, the Fédération Equestre Internationale, presided over by H.R.H. Princess Haya Bint Al Hussein, has chosen France for this new chapter in the history of equestrian sport at the highest level.

Before the UEFA EURO 2016 and the 2018 Ryder Cup, the seventh edition of the World Equestrian Games in 2014 marks the beginning of a whole series of great sporting events; pushing France firmly into the international sporting spotlight.

From 23 August to 7 September 2014, the attention of horse lovers everywhere will be focused on Normandy - host to what will be a fortnight of equestrian excellence. The best athletes of the moment, riders, drivers, vaulters and horses, will all get together in the spirit of fraternity and sporting prowess.



## OF WORLD EQUESTRIAN GAMES

After the 2010 Games in Kentucky, **the event is returning to Europe where it was first created in 1990**. Normandy is particularly honoured to play host to the largest equestrian event in the world, and to organise the Games for the very first time in France.

Celebrated every four years and alternating with the Olympic Games, **the World Equestrian Games are undoubtedly the biggest equestrian event in the world**. The finest athletes from over **60 nations** will be up against each other in the **8 official Fédération Équestre Internationale disciplines**:

- Jumping
- Dressage
- Eventing
- Driving
- Reining
- Vaulting
- Endurance
- Para-Dressage

Three of the aforementioned are Olympic disciplines (Jumping, Dressage and Eventing) with Para-Dressage being represented at the Paralympics. Horse riding is the only Olympic and Paralympic sport to have both sexes competing in the same competition and where the athlete and horse both receive medals. The upcoming edition will also be featuring two demonstration disciplines for the general public to discover: **Horse-Ball and Polo**.


# THE VALUES OF THE 2014 EDITION

# EQUESTRIAN COMPETITIONS OF EXCELLENCE

## THE OFFICIAL DISCIPLINES

### JUMPING



► France's number one equestrian sport and without a doubt, the world's best known equestrian discipline. The same horse and rider combination are expected to complete a series of obstacles, the objective of which is to control speed, trajectory and balance. Nail-biting suspense guaranteed at D'Ornano Stadium !

### EVENTING



► A 3-day "equestrian triathlon" for the same horse and rider combination. The Dressage and cross-country competitions of this event will take place in the magnificent setting of Le Pin National Stud. The Jumping competition at the D'Ornano Stadium will bring the event to a close.

### DRESSAGE



► A discipline full of harmony, Dressage is used as the groundwork for all other disciplines. The horse and rider combination perform a series of predetermined or freestyle movements in what seems to be a moment of pure magic. It could be said that the horse seems to dance all on its own. D'Ornano Stadium's spectators will be holding their breath in amazement.

### DRIVING



► Teams of 4 horses are pitted against each other in three different phases. The Dressage and Obstacle Driving take place in an arena. The Cross-Country competition or "marathon", a course over 18km, will pass through the streets of Caen and along pathways throughout the Orne valley.

## ENDURANCE



► A **spectacular competition** in Sartilly, close to the Bay of Mont-Saint-Michel. This 160 km-circular trail has a number of veterinary checkpoints. The same horse and rider combination compete in this one-day event. It is a competition that **deserves the utmost respect.**

## REINING



► One of the **most spectacular** western riding disciplines, Reining competitions will take place at the "Parc des Expositions" exhibition centre in Caen. A discipline that is more than a reflection of its western-style roots, it is ultimately a display of equestrian dressage over a period of five minutes – nothing is left to improvisation. Contestants are required to run approved patterns to different tempos.

## VAULTING



► Vaulting is a discipline full of movement with athletes competing together on teams or separately as individuals. Horses, vaulters and longueurs perform exercises in what proves to be a **captivating show**. The Zénith indoor arena will play the perfect backdrop to an event which is bound to be popular with the general public.

## PARA-DRESSAGE



► Thanks to the horse's eyes and legs, **disabled athletes can take part in competitive horse riding**. Athletes are divided into categories according to their particular disability and the courses and equipment are adapted accordingly. This competition will be staged at the "Hippodrome de la Prairie" racecourse in Caen.

# DEMONSTRATION DISCIPLINES



## POLO

► Two teams of four players equipped with mallets are mounted on quick, agile and alert horses. **Speed, contact, spirit, precision and strength...**that's what counts. A Deauville is one of France's major sites for this discipline.



## HORSE-BALL

► The sport has two teams of four riders challenging each other to get a ball into a hoop-shaped goal. This spectacular and very lively discipline can be discovered at the Saint-Lô stud farm. **The horse must be perfectly trained to be able to carry out the manoeuvres necessary to take part.**

## AN EVENT IN THE HEART OF CAEN


**S**even of the competitions will be staged in the region's capital, Caen. This centralised approach means that existing facilities will be used for the event:

 **D'Ornano Stadium:** the opening and closing ceremonies, the Jumping and Dressage competitions, as well as the Jumping test of the Eventing competition.

 **The "Zénith" indoor arena:** the ideal set-up for Vaulting competitions.

 **The exhibition centre** will be the event's organisational nerve centre as well as host to the Reining competitions, the Games Village and its exhibits, restaurants and entertainment.

 **The Prairie racecourse:** Para-Dressage and Driving competitions.

# EQUESTRIAN COMPETITIONS OF EXCELLENCE



## AN EVENT IN THE HEART OF CAEN

With competitions to be staged all around this part of the country, Normandy will further consolidate its place as the leading equestrian region in France.

The Cross-Country and Dressage phases of the Eventing competition will be held at **Le Pin National Stud** in the Orne area.



Bay of Mont Saint-Michel

**The Bay of Mont-Saint-Michel** (in the Manche area) will provide a magnificent backdrop for the 160 km-Endurance encounter that will set off from the town of Sartilly to circle around the bay.

The towns of **Saint-Lô** (Manche) and **Deauville** (Calvados area) both boast high-quality equestrian facilities and will each host a demonstration discipline: Horse-Ball and Polo.



# FESTIVITIES AND NON-SPORTING PROGRAMME

The artistic and cultural programme will have the leading territorial players getting involved in the 15 months leading up to the event. It will promote creativity, the Norman cultural identity, public involvement, ground-breaking initiatives. It will also bring together artists, associations, equestrian centres, athletes, educational and cultural organisations for a common purpose.

# FESTIVITIES AND NON-SPORTING PROGRAMME



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## LIVING THE EQUESTRIAN SPIRIT

Horses mean different things to different people: horses for freedom, horses for sensations, horses for aesthetics, horses for show...

The enormous celebration being lined up in Normandy will **showcase equestrian culture and bring together a diverse public**. The focus will be on the different types of bond that humans have with horses all around the world and since the dawn of time. This will be the starting point, bringing everyone together, irrespective of their age or background. This common theme will help to structure each and every activity and even give direction to the opening ceremony.

## LIVING THE EXPERIENCE TOGETHER!

We are talking about a region that is **proud of its know-how**; a region that is getting ready to **host the largest international equestrian event and the participation of over 60 nations**. In 2013, the organisation will be launching an appeal for **3,000 volunteers**. Their role, along with the Norman people in general, will be to promote the event all over the region of Normandy and further afield.





## CREATING INTEREST THROUGHOUT THE REGION

The non-sporting event programme will push Normandy into the limelight with its varied line-up of musical, artistic and educational activities all over the region; both in and around the competition sites. There will be concerts, film screenings and shows throughout the two weeks of the Games.

## THE ORGANISING COMMITTEE GETS ITS VERY OWN EXPERT

The event's artistic and cultural consultant, **Bernard Faivre d'Arcier** brings a wealth of experience to the Normandy 2014 Organising Committee. A man of far-reaching culture, whether it be in theatre, dance, cinema or broadcasting, Bernard Faivre d'Arcier has made quite a mark in French and European cultural circles during his fifteen years at the head of the Festival of Avignon. **He will be casting an expert eye on proceedings, bringing the ideas and experience necessary so that festivities organised in Normandy fit in with the spirit of the event.**

## WELCOME TO THE VILLAGE !

The Alltech FEI World Equestrian Games™ 2014 in Normandy village will remain open for the entire **15 days of festivities** in the very heart of Caen. A vast outdoor arena will allow visitors to discover exciting equestrian themes: **country and western, the circus, sporting exploits and Normandy**. The emphasis will be on demonstrations, getting to know working horses and letting people discover different equestrian trades and sports. The village will be open to the general public all day long at affordable entrance rates. Entry will be free for ticket-holders.



# A TERRITORIAL PROJECT WORKING TOGETHER WITH A COMMON GOAL : 15 DAYS OF FESTIVITIES, 15 MONTHS OF MOBILISATION, A 15-YEAR LEGACY

Given the importance that the horse and equestrian culture has throughout France, the public sector stakeholders have always believed, from the very moment they submitted Normandy's candidacy, that **the event would be a catalyst for development in Normandy**. It is for this reason that they have set up a "Territorial Project" linked with the Alltech FEI World Equestrian Games™ 2014 with the aim of leaving a mark on the region for a long time to come.

## SHOWCASING THE REGION'S APPEAL

Making Normandy **THE tourist and horse community destination** of the moment is probably one of the region's biggest ambitions. **Normandy's major horse trails** have been upgraded to attract even more new visitors. A major drive to encourage training has been undertaken as **to forge links between tourism professionals and the equine community** (product development, promoting the use of the English language and cultural awareness). During the event, The Games Village will **promote the diversity of the sector's activities**: trades and training courses, demonstrations, commercial and professional areas.

## INVESTING IN THE LONG TERM

The competition sites will benefit from **an investment programme to facilitate the organisation of the event itself and which also encourages long-term sustainability**.

- **A CCI 4\* course at Le Pin National Stud:** venue for the Dressage and Cross-Country phases of the eventing competition. As of 2014, **competitions of the very highest level** will be staged here, thanks to its all-new track.
- The Endurance competition in the Bay of Mont-Saint-Michel is made up of a 160 km circular trail that sets out from the town of Sartilly. A large number of these itineraries are designed to be used well after the event and will of course **increase the appeal of the numerous equestrian trails in the region**.
- In Caen, upgrade work to the "**Hippodrome de la Prairie**" racecourse and the Orne Valley : the development work to this vast natural space and the creation of a nature trail **will offer the general public a new urban green space in the very heart of the town**.
- **Landscape rehabilitation work between the "Parc des Expositions" and the Zénith Centre Caen** : major rehabilitation work is to be carried out; this will have a long-term knock-on effect.





## THE "NORMAN PACT": GETTING EVERYONE IN ON THE ACT

The World Equestrian Games will also be the perfect opportunity for making equestrianism and sports activities more popular. A call for project proposals will be launched early 2013. The people of Normandy will be encouraged to come up with initiatives in the field of sport, the arts and culture. Official endorsement will be given to selected projects that will then be developed in the fifteen months up to the event. The winners will be rewarded with an all expenses paid day's participation at the very heart of the event.

## THE 2014 NORMANDY CLUB

The Companies Club associated with the event aims to get together 2014 companies hand picked from amongst local craftsmen, business owners, small, medium and large enterprises, professionals and non-professionals relating to the chain... with the view of seriously highlighting the Games and displaying all of Normandy's dynamism. The Club will offer its members opportunities for mobilisation in respect of all their colleagues and associates and their network so that they can bask in the Games' glory in the most privileged of manners. A wonderful challenge ahead.

## THE WILL TO ORGANISE AN ORIGINAL AND ECO- RESPONSIBLE EVENT

A "social and innovation fund" has now been set up. Drawn from contributions from private-sector partners, (approximately 5% of sponsorship revenue), it is designed to fund projects in line with the Normandie 2014 Organising Committee's approach towards sustainable development.

## SHOWCASING THE WORKING HORSE

A "Working horse Village" will be created within the Games Village. It will allow everyone to see just how much working horses have to offer and the many uses they have. In fact, the public will have close contact with them during the entire duration of the Games; working horses will be used for transport, by the logistics teams, for car park security, waste disposal... The many initiatives and activities that are planned will only go to showcase these wonderful horses. In fact, they can be considered as a modern day form of renewable energy...



# THE PARTNERSHIP MODEL

## A SHOW OF CONFIDENCE FROM THE HIGHEST AUTHORITIES

This show of confidence towards France and Normandy is down to the **collective effort of the Lower Normandy region, the French State and the Fédération Française d'Équitation.**

## THE « JEM NORMANDIE 2014 » GIP

**A public interest group (GIP) presided over by Laurent Beauvais, President of the Region of Lower Normandy has been created to organise the event.** This decision was in response to the size of the project, the number and status of the involved parties, with the notable implication of the local and state governing bodies. The Normandie 2014 GIP guarantees the sound management of public funds. This will be done through a completely transparent, democratic and accountable manner with regards to the competition, logistics, marketing, communication and media, finances... **The GIP is the preferred set-up for the organisation of major sporting events in France** (GIP Paris 2003 Athletics, GIP Rugby 2007, GIP Olympic Games Bids 2002 and 2008).

## A SECURED BUDGET

The draft investment and operating budget raised by the 2014 World Equestrian Games' partners is estimated at over € 72 m, with funding mainly provided by the State, the region of Lower Normandy and the local governing bodies of Normandy. **By the end of 2012, 82% of the budget had been secured – all of this has been done without ticket sales.**

Competitions, site design & layout, security & safety procedures, transport, public services.


### MANAGING

Working closely with the sports director, Laurent Cellier and with the Organising Committee's different departments, each of the eight discipline managers is responsible for determining a road map for his/her discipline (identification of human and material needs...). During the event, they will also take on an added responsibility; that of sporting director of their particular competition. Each discipline manager will be involved in recruiting and training volunteers; this will undoubtedly help to make the competition a major collective success. In a sense, each and every manager will act as an ambassador to both the competitors and the entire international equestrian community.

# SPORTS

When it comes to making decisions about the health and welfare of the world's finest athletes, the sports management team has quite a task on its hands. It needs to have a complete picture of everything that concerns the horses, riders, drivers and vaulters who have been selected to represent their countries in Normandy. Thanks to a clear set of guidelines, it is in a position to guarantee a top-level competition, whilst not forgetting to make it accessible to the public. Its key tasks can be divided into four main areas.

## ● COMPETITION MANAGEMENT

Even the minutest detail has to be taken into consideration to ensure that competitions take place in the best possible conditions for everyone. This means providing daily schedules and timetables for the use of facilities (riding arenas and rings, stables...), establishing which human and technical resources will be at disposal at any given time or "mapping out" when and where the various participants will be in action (competitors, jury members, volunteers...). Every single aspect needs to be synchronised to perfection well in advance. One could say it's a task worthy of a master watchmaker...

## ● DELEGATION SERVICES

Sixty nations will be up against each other with nearly 1,000 athletes and just as many horses. The national federations are already getting ready for the event and have begun looking at it from different angles: accommodation, transportation, venue layout, accreditation, catering, general logistics... The national officials' task is greatly facilitated by the Normandie 2014 Organising Committee's exclusive contact who is able to centralise any questions/requests that may come up. In 2013, with just one year to go, the national officials will all make a trip to Normandy to get an idea of the scale of the event. This will indeed allow everyone to concentrate on the sporting side in 2014.

## ● HEALTH AND VETERINARY ISSUES

During the event, 1,000 horses of all types will be grouped together in France's leading equestrian area. This high concentration calls for extra sanitary vigilance and significant means of intervention. Since her appointment in February 2013, the Vet Services Manager has been responsible for monitoring health risks in conjunction with the relevant authorities. In addition, she has started organising veterinary care for each of the venues and disciplines and has been working on anti-doping efforts. A multidisciplinary team will be assigned to each venue to work in close cooperation with the delegations and the authorities.

## ● CENTRAL INFORMATION DESK FOR HORSES

Peden Bloodstock has been selected as the Designated Shipping Agent. This highly qualified company will organise international air freight (15 to 20% of the horses) and handle logistical, customs and health formalities for all of the horses, equipment and participants; making sure that they all arrive at the competition venues both safely and legally. From the moment they set off for Normandy to the moment they return home again, horses will be in the necessary conditions of comfort to guarantee their best performances in a safe and serene environment. This will allow them to give their very best during the competitions. Particular attention will be paid to stabling arrangements during the event, such as scheduling the use of stables, organising their on-site location and providing disinfected stables as well as additional services (nutrition, farriers...). Security will be entrusted to FEI-qualified stewards, who will supervise proceedings.

## EQUESTRIAN AND SHOWGROUND SURFACES:

Specialised providers were chosen in 2012 for their expertise in each of the disciplines and for their experience in international competitions. They are already working on test materials in order to guarantee the best possible final composition.

## EVENT PREPARATORY TRIALS/TESTS:

Test events for most of the disciplines are scheduled for 2013. Sartilly will be home to the Endurance test, Le Pin National Stud will welcome Eventing, whilst Driving test will take place in the city of Caen. The D'Ornano Stadium will host Jumping and Dressage tests in June 2014. The Organising Committee's different departments have identified all the possible situations that need to be tested in real-life circumstances, so that everything runs smoothly on the "big day". In particular, the sports and layout/design teams hope to validate the technical and logistical options they have already planned. Nothing will be left to chance; sufficient time needs to be allowed for if changes are to be made.

## YOUR QUESTIONS OUR ANSWERS

### 3,000 VOLUNTEERS – THE ESSENCE OF THE GAMES

They were perhaps born and bred in Normandy or they are perhaps "adopted" Normans. Maybe they come from further afield, but it really doesn't matter because every single person is invited to join in this great group project. There is a place for everyone, for all those who are looking to come into contact with the public, **to live an exceptional moment and to gain working experience at an international event.** Online recruitment of candidates aged 18 or over will be organised – volunteers just need to be highly motivated and available during the 15 days of competitions. Some 1,000 will be trained for the test events in 2013 and a further 1,500 to 2,000 will join them in 2014. **After registration, candidates will benefit from an information and training period.**



### MEDIA

Media accreditation will be delivered from **February 2014.** A media centre within the area of Caen will be chosen and will be close to the main competition venues.

### COMMUNICATION

There will be unified information systems and high-quality service at all the competition sites: **display screens, transmission and management of data and results, timekeeping, sound equipment,** the Organising Committee's/officials/media IT and communications equipment.
