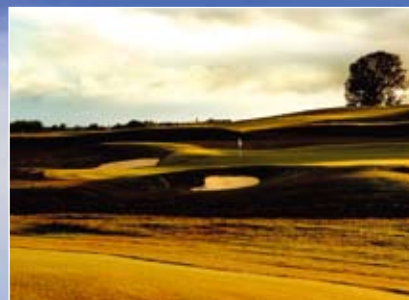

What Europe's leading airlines charge to take your clubs on the plane

RYANAIR: £30 per flight in advance, £40 per flight at the airport.

AER LINGUS: £26 per flight in advance, £35 per flight at the airport.

AIRBALTIC: £26 per flight in advance, £35 per flight at the airport.

JET2: £20 per flight in advance, £25 per flight at the airport.

EASYJET: £18.50 per flight in advance, £26 per flight at the airport. Maximum weight 32kg.

BMI BABY: £17.99 per flight in advance, £23 per flight at the airport.

MONARCH: £17.50 per flight in advance, £22.50 per flight at the airport.

AIR FRANCE: No charge if under 20kg (£35 per flight if it's heavier).

BRITISH AIRWAYS: No charge.
